

Dunwoody Fourth of July Parade 2021 Covid-19 Safety Measures

<u>Statement from the Parade Committee</u>: On behalf of the Dunwoody Homeowners Association and in cooperation with the City of Dunwoody the 2021 Dunwoody Fourth of July Parade will take place as scheduled. This year the parade is on the legal holiday of Monday July 5th.

Our number one goal is to make sure everyone is safe and remains healthy. Therefore, we have the following safety guidelines in place for all to follow.

*Parade Participants: Entries will be spaced in accordance with CDC regulations at the start of the parade. Entries are to keep a safe distance apart while on the parade route. Masks are required by those handing out materials, bottled water, candy, etc. to spectators. Because the parade is outdoors, parade participant masks are not mandatory, however, they are encouraged.

*Parade Spectators: Current CDC space and mask guidelines must be followed along the parade route.

*As of July 5, specific precautions will be implemented based on public health officials and CDC guidance as well as the state of the pandemic at the time of the event. The parade committee and the City of Dunwoody will continue to assess all COVID-19 safety measures as conditions evolve. We will keep the public updated on any changes.
